The Campus Law Centre is pleased to announce a Competition (Multiple Choice Questions) in collaboration with The National Commission for Women for creating awareness about legal rights of women among the students. The students may be tested in respect of provisions of the Constitution and laws relating to women's rights and empowerment. The competition includes topics relating to the following laws:

- (i) Constitution of India mainly, the Preamble, Fundamental Rights, Directive Principles of State Policy, Fundamental Duties, including Article 33 and Article 226 thereof.
- (ii) National Commission for Women Act, 1990 (20 of 1990)
- (iii) Dowry Prohibition Act, 1961
- (iv) Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005
- (v) The Sexual Harassment of Women at Work place (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal Act) Act, 2013
- (vi) The Criminal Law Amendment Act, 2013
- (vii) The Maternity Benefit Act, 1961
- (viii) The Medical Termination of Pregnancy Act, 1971 (34 of 1971)
- (ix) The Immoral Traffic (Prevention) Act, 1956
- (x) The Pre-Conception and Pre-Natal Diagnostic Techniques (Prohibition of Sex Selection) Act, 1994
- (xi) The Minimum Wages Act, 1948
- (xii) SC and the ST (Prevention of Atrocities) Amendment Act, 2015
- (xii) The Scheduled Tribes and other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2008
