ABOUT IAFL STUDENTSHIP

The Campus Law Centre under the aegis of International Academy of Family Lawyers (IAFL) is pleased to announce IAFL Studentship, 2018 to the students of Campus Law Centre.

- Under the studentship, selected, CLC student will be offered internship abroad.
- The studentship will cover some minor expenses and will be with one of the fellows in U.S.A, England, and other English speaking countries. The student will live with IAFL host. The host will be selected by IAFL.
- The studentship will be for a period of 2-3 weeks, depending upon the availability of host who will be a member of IAFL.
- The student internship will be during convenient time in June-July, 2018.

SELECTION PROCESS

- Selection process includes essay competition and interview.

ESSAY COMPETITION

Topic: *"Whether 1993 Hague Convention on Protection of Children and Co-operation in Respect of Intercountry Adoption facilitates Intercountry Adoption by LGBT?"*

GUIDELINES FOR SUBMISSION

- The essay must be submitted in English only.

- Submission shall be made only in MS -Word format (.doc/.docx). PDF format will not be accepted.
- The essay should be the original work of the author. Any kind of plagiarism will lead to disqualification.
- The essay should be accompanied by a cover page/letter giving details of the author such as name of the author/student, roll no., year, address and contact details.
- The essay published elsewhere or selected/ submitted for publication elsewhere shall be disqualified.
- The name of the author should not be mentioned anywhere in the essay.
- Abstract should not be more than 300 words.
- The word limit for the essay is 3000–5000 words, not including footnotes.
- The essays should be typed in: Times New Roman, Font Size 12 and Line Spacing 1.5. Headings: Times New Roman, Font Size 14, Bold. The footnotes must be typed in: Times New Roman, Font Size 10 and Line Spacing 1. The margins should be 1” or 2.54 cm on all sides. All text should be justified.
- Co-authorship is not permitted.

SUBMISSION PROCEDURE

- A soft copy of the submission has to be mailed to pic@clc.du.ac.in
- Subject of the e-mail should be “Submission: Essay Competition, 2018”.
- Participant shall name the file as “Participant’s name_Topic”.
- The essay shall be mailed as an attachment in ‘.doc’ or ‘.docx’ format only.
- The body of the email must specify:
 - Name of the Author.

- Roll no. & Year.
- Pass Port No. with Expiry Date
- E-mail address and Contact No. of Author

ELIGIBILITY

The competition is open only to the students pursuing LL.B. from Campus Law Centre, University of Delhi.
