



REPORT OF THE LECTURE ON E-RESOURCES AND OTHER RESOURCES AVAILABLE IN THE DELHI UNIVERSITY LIBRARY SYSTEM

As a part of the orientation programme for the first year LL.B students a lecture on “E-Resources and Other Resources Available in the Delhi University Library System” was conducted on 5th October 2016 to make students aware about the skills and methods to retrieve relevant online information on academic research. The Lectures was conducted at the Seminar Hall, Campus Law Centre, Faculty of Law, University of Delhi from 3:00 pm to 4:00 pm. was the speaker. The speaker highlighted numerous online information searching techniques which are available on both Delhi University IP and other open access. How to select the right key words in order to get accurate result, Boolean search, different types of subscribed and open access database e-resources, etc. were practically explained by the speaker. The speaker also emphasised the importance of proper citation and reference, ethical use of the facilities of library and how to avoid plagiarism. The lecture was

followed by question and answer session where students were very inquisitive with their queries.
