#### **Delayed Submission on OBE Portal:**

1. In case of poor internet connectivity/any unforeseen technical glitches etc. the student is advised to submit his/her OBE answer script beyond the specific time period with the valid reasons and keep documentary evidences ready with them for its presentation on demand. The maximum time limit for delayed submission is 60 minutes. However all such cases will be examined and accordingly the answer scripts will be sent for evaluation.

#### **Delayed Submission on Email:**

- 2. Email submission should be only under the extreme emergency situations only if the submission through portal is not possible. Please remember documentary evidence of non- submission/failed submission/technical glitches along with 4-5 snap shots/screen shot/pictures of failed OBE portal submission at different time to the portal should be preserved by the students for submission of such evidence on demand. Nodal Officers can reject the E- mail submission if reason given is not valid.
- 3. E-mails sent by the students before 3 pm (prior to completion of 5 hours) shall not be accepted. Answer script sent through email should be only in PDF format. Attachment of OBE answer script with Google Drive Link or any linkwill NOT be considered. The students submitting the scripts through Email may face extra

ordinary delay in declaration of their results due to verification and validation process of submission.

- 4. <u>Dual submissions and partial submission i.e. both on OBE Portal and Email will</u> not be accepted.
- 5. The students <u>will NOT receive</u> a confirmation/acknowledgement email in case they have submitted their OBE answer scripts through email.
- 6. Prefer OBE portal submission rather than email to avoid complex procedures of evaluation associated with it. Results of answer scripts submitted to Nodal Officer via email will be delayed at least by one month or more as it happened during all previous OBEs. No request will be entertained by the Nodal Officers for early result declaration after email submission.

#### 7. OBE Answer Script first page:

On first page, the students shall write the following details (<u>providing any other</u> personal information like email ID, Mobile No and Name of the College will be treated as unfair means and action will be taken as per University rules):

Please note that these details are not to be written before each question. The page numbers are also to be mentioned at the top of each sheet.

- 8. Ensure that you are accessing the OBE portal in a good network area at your place to avoid chaos on the day of your exam.
- 9. Step by Step guidelines and detailed instructions are already available at <a href="https://obe.uod.ac.in">https://obe.uod.ac.in</a> and exam branch website. Students are advised to read carefully before exam and follow them accordingly.
- 10. **PwBD students** also need to submit OBE answer scripts on the OBE portal. **Email** submission by PwBD students (till 4.30 pm) to the concerned Nodal Officer
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should be only under the extreme emergency situations only if the submission through OBE portal is not possible. In such a situation, they may submit their answer scripts in PDF only at the dedicated email of the respective semester i.e. obe4@clc.du.ac.in & obe2@clc.du.ac.in.

#### 11. Email submission results may be delayed.

Students are advised to read the above mentioned instructions carefully and refrain from posing queries related to the instructions reiterated above.
