Moot Court Society

It is a highly dedicated cell which aims to provide a platform to students to inculcate and enhance advocacy skills. The Society conducts training programs and workshops regularly honing drafting and argumentative of nascent legal minds. There are various annual events conducted by the society such as FIM (Freshers Induction Moot), CIM (Common Induction Moot) and CLC-Competition Commission of India Moot Court Competition. It provides an extensive learning process and shapes the dynamics of legality for students. The Mooting society also organises the most famous and prestigious K.K Luthra Moot Court Competition every year which witnesses participation from various national and international law schools.

Debate and Discussions Society

It is a unique forum that promotes free thought and the exchange of opinions. Discussion being the ethos of the institution, DDS forms a natural facilitator of that spirited culture. The DDS hosts a plethora of events covering various facets of the art of debate and discussion to provide ideas and expressions with a platform they rightly deserve.

Its flagship initiatives include: CLC Opinion Project (Intra college debate), CLC PLUGGED in (blogosphere), CLC Townhall (Panel Discussion Platform) and CLC National Debate Fest.

Legal Aid Society

It is deeply committed to its two main objectives; creating legal awareness and providing legal aid with the assistance of a lawyer at the Legal Services Clinic (LSC), CLC. The legal aid society aims to disseminate legal information among those who cannot afford legal services, by way of legal literacy programs in and around campus in consonance with the provisions of the Legal Services Authorities Act 1987. LSC works in close collaboration with the Delhi State Legal Services Authority (DSLISA) and has been successful in providing free legal assistance because of the active participation of the Para-Legal Volunteers (PLVs) in collaboration with the empanelled lawyers. Its budding initiative 'Awaaz -The Blog' publishes articles intending to encourage diverse legal discourse on contemporary issues to emphasize the importance of socially relevant legal education in the discipline of law and its recognition as a sine qua non for proper dispensation of justice.

Corporate and Commercial Laws Society

It is an initiative aiming to create awareness of the practical aspects of corporate law and commercial laws, by promoting students to research and enabling them to participate in training sessions/workshops. The practice of corporate law is based on a strong legal foundation built by the study of law along with top-grade practical skills and work ethics. The society's activities are thus directed towards imparting the necessary skills required in the practice of corporate law that will help in bridging the industry-academia gap. The student members are trained and guided through the society's engagements with law firms and institutions that allows ideas to be shared and professional relationships to be forged.

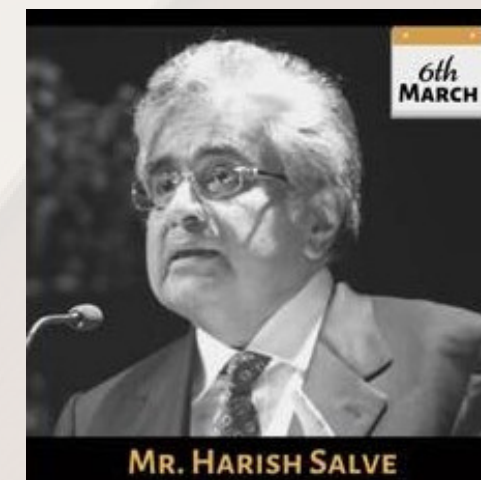

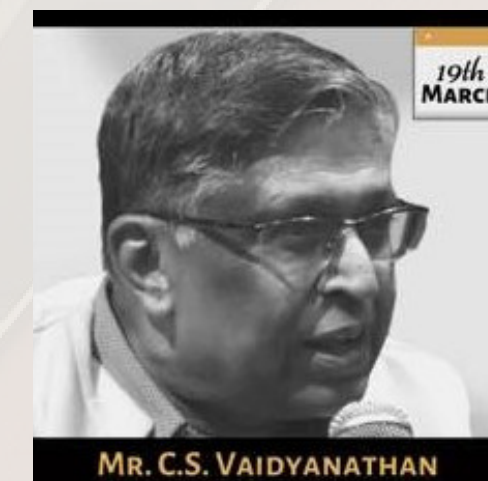

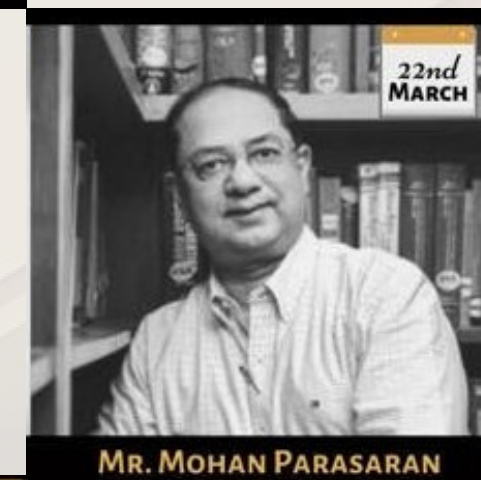
