

I. COURTROOM LEGENDS- Keynote Series



(Date: 6th March 2021)



(Date: 19th March 2021)



(Date: 22nd March 2021)






5. The Valedictory Session




Evolution of Constitutional Law by Supreme Court of India




II. INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE ON LAW & SPIRITUALITY (ICLS)






V. DDS VIRTUAL WORKSHOPS
