


II. WORKSHOPS


a) INTERNATIONAL WORKSHOP ON LAWS GOVERNING AVIATION IN INDIA (2 Days)




VI. <u>INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE ON LAW & SPIRITUALITY (ICLS)</u>
