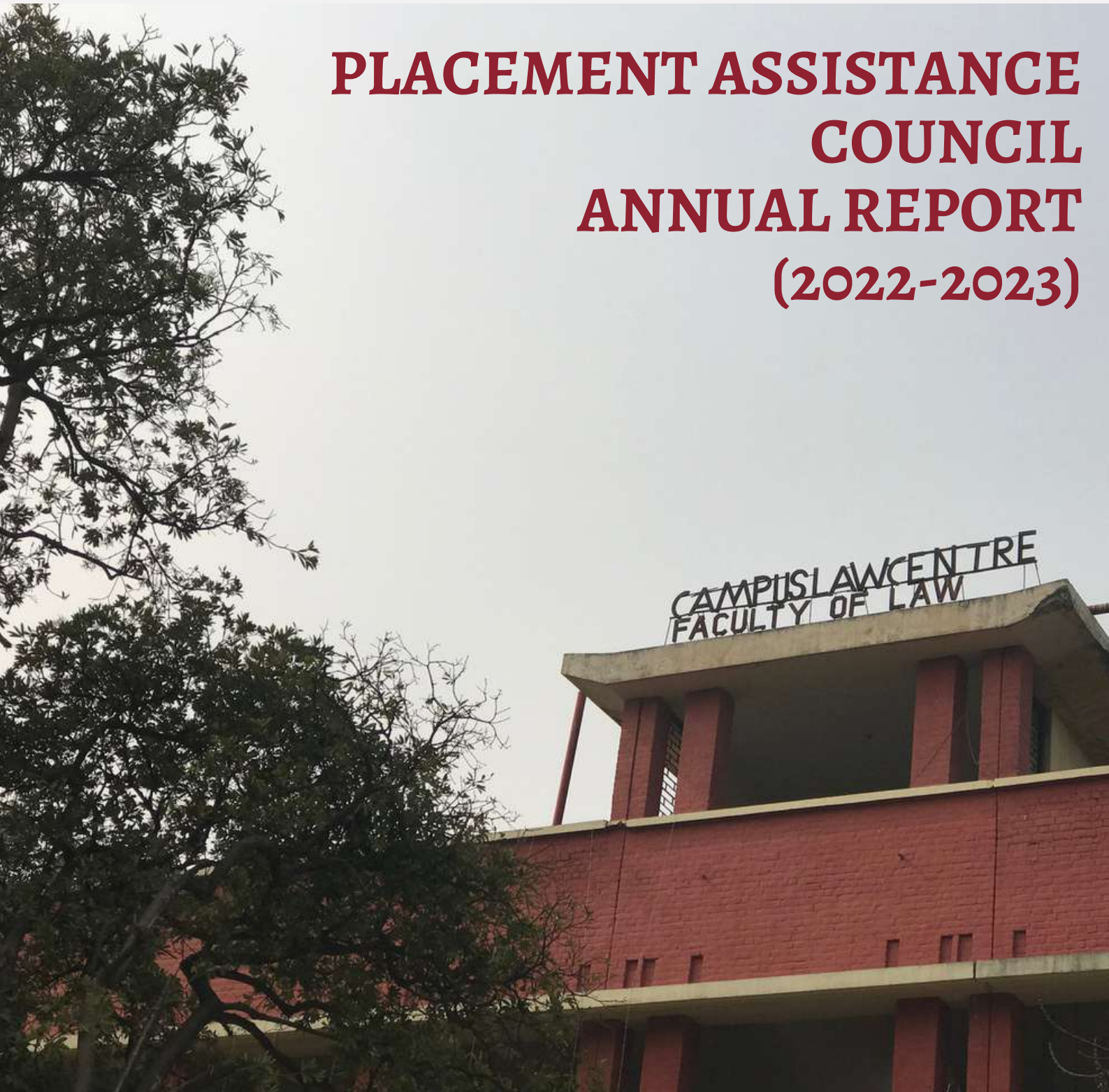

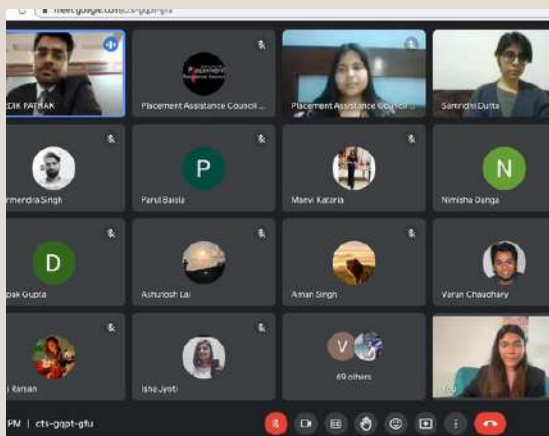
Speaker- Mr Sumeer Malik, Director of Eastern Book Company (EBC)
