## NOTICE

### Admission in LL.B. III/V Semester for the Academic Year 2026-27

All those students of LL.B. 1<sup>st</sup>/2<sup>nd</sup> year (Academic Session 2025-26), who have not been detained, are being ***promoted provisionally*** to LL.B. 2<sup>nd</sup>/3<sup>rd</sup> Year respectively. However, all the provisionally promoted students are permitted to attend the classes of their next year of course of study so as to meet the attendance criteria of 70% attendance in each semester.

All the students of 1<sup>st</sup> year and 2<sup>nd</sup> year, who have already **cleared 5/15** papers respectively and were not detained in II/IV Term, are **eligible for admission to LL.B. 2<sup>nd</sup> / 3<sup>rd</sup> Year** respectively during the Academic Session **2026-27**. Students are hereby advised to submit their Admission Form (available on the Campus Law Centre website) in the office of Campus Law Centre along with the following documents latest by 15.07.2026:-

1. Self-attested photocopies of all the marks-sheets.
2. Photocopy of college ID card (previous year 2025-26)
3. Photocopy of Admit Card (Exam held in May-June, 2026)

It may be ensured that all the columns of the Admission Form are duly filled, as incomplete forms cause an unnecessary delay in the admission process. No portion of the Form should be left blank or incomplete.

Those students who have **not cleared 5/15 papers** are required to submit a provisional promotion undertaking (**available on the CLC website**) latest by 24.07.2026. Students are advised to fill the same subject option(s) in Admission Form as were filled by them in the Google form circulated earlier. In case of any discrepancies between the two, the Google form option shall prevail.

Please come through the relevant windows between 10:00 AM to 12:30 PM and 02.00 PM to 03.30 PM only and refrain from entering the office for submitting your Admission Form and queries related thereto.

It may specifically be noted that those students, who could not pass the Paper No. LB-501 – “Moot Court Exercise and Internship” in the earlier semester, are required to submit an application in the office of Campus Law Centre along with the copy of relevant mark-sheet & College Identity Card.

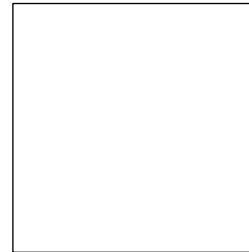
