

<u>Re-Admission in LL.B. III/V Semester for the</u> <u>Academic Year 2025-26</u>

All the students of the CLC (including detained in LL.B. III^{rd} / N^{th} in previous academic year / those who were Absent or ER in LB-501 (Moot Court Exercise and Internship in the earlier semester), are hereby informed that re-admission in LL.B. III^{rd} / V^{th} Semester for the Academic Year 2025-26 has started w.e.f. 21.07.2025. The students are required to fill re-admission form (as provided below). The Re-admission forms are required to be submitted physically in the CLC office between 10:00 AM - 12:30 PM & 02:00 PM - 03:30 PM (Except Saturday and Sunday) for verification.

The Last date of submission of Re-Admission form is 28.07.2025.

Students who have cleared a minimum of 05 papers for IIIrd Semester and 15 papers

for Vth Semester based on their results in Semester examination

are required to submit their **re-admission form** along with supporting documents mention below in CLC office for verification:

- **1.** All semester marksheets (I/II/III/IV) with copy of last attended Admit Card –self attested.
- **2.** Duly Filled Admission form. (Optional Subjects mentioned below this notice)
- **3.** Hand written application for those who are detained/Absent/ ER in LB-501 required.
