Prof.(Dr) Irene Calboli from Texas A&M University School of Law, United States presented her enlightened talk on the topic " AN INTRODUCTION TO THE PROTECTION OF GEOGRAPHICAL INDICATIONS: INTERNATIONAL AND COMPARATIVES PERSPECTIVES" through a webinar on 22nd May, 2020 at 3:00 pm (IST).
