The duty of the Commission is to carry out the objectives enumerated under the Competition Act, 2002, i.e., to prohibit anti-competitive agreements, abuse of dominant position by enterprises and regulate combinations (acquisition, acquiring of control and M&A), which cause or are likely to cause an appreciable adverse effect on competition within India. The broad objective of the Act is to create and sustain fair competition in the economy that will provide a 'level playing field' to the producers and make the markets. To this end, the mandate of the CCI includes eliminating practices having adverse effect on competition; inspiring businesses to be fair, competitive and innovative; protection of the interests of consumers, and ensuring freedom of trade in the markets of India. To achieve its objectives, the Commission engages in wide-ranging advocacy programmes like competition assessment of policies and legislations by collaborating with educational institutions, conducting training sessions, panel discussions and conferences on issues in competition law, offering internship opportunities to students and also organizing national level essay writing competitions.
