About IITBHU MUN

Model United Nations conferences are academic simulations of the United Nations where students play the role of delegates (Country representatives) from different countries, which are assigned to them and attempt to solve the pressing real-world issues with the policies and perspectives of their assigned country. The deliberations happen by the procedures and protocols followed by the United Nations. In each conference, multiple sessions are held for each committee and the solutions put forth by the delegates are materialized into structured resolutions to be voted upon by the respective committee.

IIT BHU Model United Nations is a well-known, internationally recognized, and one of India's premier MUN conferences. It has undergone stellar growth over its incredible journey since 2012, attracting about 4000+ delegates from 22 nationalities over its 11 incredible editions. Its distinct appeal stems from its roots in India's spiritual capital and the resolve of raising standards with every passing edition.

The 12th edition of the IITBHU Model United Nations conference will be held from **29th September to 1st October 2023**. Hundreds of delegates are expected to participate in the conference worldwide. The 11th edition of the IITBHU Model United Nations conference was held in collaboration with premier organisations like **UNIC for India** and **Bhutan**, and **patronage from UNESCO-INCCU** from 3-5 February 2023.

The conference, endorsed by the Hon'ble Prime Minister of India, Shri Narendra Modi, the Indian Ambassador to Uzbekistan, Shri Manish Prabhat, and the Chief Guest, Dr Ajay Kumar, Former Defence Secretary of India, attracted participants from various countries across continents. Agenda: Deliberation upon the effects of globalization and capitalism on healthcare with emphasis on private healthcare facilities

G20 stands for a group of 20, a committee of 19 nations, and the European Union (EU). Consisting of the world's largest economies, the G20 fosters collaboration with international organizations to enhance global economic governance.



UNCSW

Agenda: Women's full and effective participation and decision-making in public life, as well as the elimination of violence, for achieving gender equality and the empowerment of all women and girls

The United Nations Commission on the Status of Women is the global intergovernmental body dedicated to the promotion of gender equality and the empowerment of women.



UNHRC

Agenda: Deliberation on the right to life for people living with HIV/AIDS
The UNHRC is the intergovernmental body within the United Nations responsible for promoting and protecting human rights worldwide. Its primary function includes monitoring the practice of human rights among the member states.



JPC

Agenda: Discussing the socio-economic development in India with emphasis on delimitation and reorganization of territories

A specialised committee made up of representatives from both houses of a parliamentary system is known as a joint parliamentary committee. Its goal is to look into and research certain important national issues.





AIPPM

Agenda: Evaluating the existing delimitation criteria and suggesting reforms for a more fair and representative demarcation of constituencies

All India Political Party Meet (AIPPM) is a ground for discussion and debate open to all political parties of India.



UNFCCC

Agenda: Assessing the impact of Climate Change with special emphasis on Small Island Developing States (SIDS)
